



60 PLUS SENIOR CITIZEN SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Senior Adult Scholarship Program: A free tuition program for senior citizens (persons aged 60 or over) who meet the admission requirements, in state residency requirements, and attend public two-year postsecondary institutions in Alabama.

1. Complete application for Admissions to the College.
2. Prospective student must enroll in courses for **Credit or Audit**. Scholarship is not available for Continuing Education Unit (CEU) courses.
3. Scholarship will only pay **Tuition** one time for a course attempted. Repeat courses will not be paid for and will be the responsibility of the student. Student is responsible for **Registration Fees and All Books and Supplies charges**.
4. An official copy of the High School, GED and/or College Transcripts is/are required by the Admissions Office. Official transcripts must come directly from the School to the Admissions Office.
5. A student may be allowed to enroll for one quarter without the official transcripts **but** will not be allowed to enroll a second quarter without the High School, GED, or College Transcripts.
6. Each class that the student wants to enroll in must have at least ten (10) credit students enrolled exclusive of the 60-Plus Scholarship students.
