Qualifications for this Coastal Alabama Community College Scholarship

- Must apply for admission to Coastal Alabama Community College. DO NOT include your Application for Admission with this application.
- A student must graduate high school with the class of 2018 with a minimum credit-based or standard diploma.
- Must have a minimum 3.5 unweighted GPA and a minimum score of 24 on the ACT test or a minimum score of 1180 on the SAT test. (Presidential)
- Must make a minimum score of 16 on the ACT test or minimum score of 870 on the SAT test. (Dean's)

Checklist

- Only one application allowed per student.
- Attach a current High School transcript and ACT or SAT scores to this application. (Unofficial transcripts will be accepted.)
- Must sign the application for it to be reviewed.

Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.

Scholarship recipients are allowed to attend any campus location or online classes unless otherwise specified by the campus sponsor.

Notifications will be sent to the student's Coastal Alabama email address.

Students are encouraged, not required, to complete a FAFSA in order to qualify for other federal grant and loan opportunities. The FAFSA can be filled out online and can be found at www.FAFSA.ED.gov. Coastal Alabama's FAFSA code is 001061.
